

# PROGRAM STATEMENT

International Confederation of Free Nations

We, the founding members of the International Confederation of Free Nations (hereinafter referred to as the “Confederation”), united in the spirit of freedom, responsibility and respect for the natural order, hereby solemnly present the Program Statement, by which we define our values, goals and the basic strategic framework of the Confederation’s activities.

## I. VISION AND MISSION

The Confederation represents a voluntary community of free nations that honor the principles of sovereignty, traditional values, direct democracy and the family as the cornerstone of society.

Our vision is a world: where nations decide their own destiny without external interference, where tradition and cultural diversity are not a threat but a source of strength, where human rights are based on natural law and moral order, where power comes from below – from the citizen, not from the center.

## II. STRATEGIC FOUNDATIONS OF THE CONFEDERATION

### 1. Direct democracy and citizen sovereignty

The Confederation is based on the inalienable right of nations and citizens to direct decision-making. We commit to promoting: binding referendums at local, national and international levels, recallability of elected representatives by popular decision, transparency and open governance of public affairs, digital platforms and popular assemblies for active citizen participation.

### 2. Protection and support of the traditional family

The family, based on the union of a man and a woman, is the fundamental unit of society, the bearer of culture, life and continuity. The Confederation will: support pro-family policies and large households, protect the rights of parents to raise children in accordance with traditional values, defend society from destructive ideologies that threaten the natural order.

### 3. Sovereignty and equality among nations

Each member nation has the same rights and responsibilities. The Confederation rejects any form of hegemony, centralization or interference in the internal affairs of its members.

### 4. Cultural and linguistic integrity

We support the restoration, protection and development of indigenous languages, customs, historical consciousness and spiritual heritage, as pillars of the identity of nations.

5. Independent economy and technological sovereignty

We build mutually beneficial economic cooperation, rooted in: the resilience of local markets, the support of independent production and research, the sharing of technologies in the service of citizens, not corporations.

6. Education and upbringing for truth

We support education free from ideological manipulation. Our schools should: develop critical thinking, moral integrity and national awareness, educate children to respect life, family and society.

7. Protection of nature and the environment

We advocate a responsible approach to nature as part of the cultural and spiritual heritage. Sustainability should be based on a balance between man, community and environment.

8. Peace, justice and peaceful resolution of disputes

The Confederation rejects any form of aggression, coercion and dominance. We resolve conflicts between members peacefully, equally, through dialogue, mediation or arbitration.

III. FINAL COMMITMENT

We, the peoples and communities associated in the Confederation, solemnly affirm: our devotion to the ideals of freedom, truth, dignity and self-determination, our readiness to protect the family, faith and tradition as the pillars of life, our will to build a new order based on the direct participation of citizens.

This Program Statement serves as the basic framework for the political and social activities of the Confederation and is binding on all its bodies and members.
